Corporate Alliance of South Africa (CASA) Membership Policy

Membership:

The members of CASA are the subscribed Affiliated Sectoral Constituencies, Organised sectoral based Provincial Structures and any other Organised Business Formations, Bodies as well as Associations admitted in accordance with the CASA constitution.

The CASA Membership form is divided into three categories:

- a. Affiliated Sectorial / Individual members/and companies
- b. Corporate members /companies
- c. Honorary members

(The membership fee for all categories is renewable each year).

a. Individual / Affiliated Sectorial members

These members shall be ADMITTED to membership and be entered in the Province Sectorial members' register data of which will be transferred to the National Office Membership. The membership of CASA is on-going – i.e. there is no limitation on membership. Everybody is expected to renew membership on an annual basis. CASA National Office Membership Department will send “reminder/ s” two months prior to the various membership expiry dates. Please note: there is a grace period of sixty (60) days after the expiry period after which period membership will then be terminated without any further notice. The fee is **R300, 00** per year. For ordinary members in each sector

b. Corporate Membership is also divided into four (4) categories:

- o Platinum Corporate Membership:
They have 100 % or more of Publicity through their internal policies / procedures and are still open for participating in CASA Activities etc. CASA to establish long-term partnerships – this category partakes in all CASA activities, serve as Advisors in their various specific areas and they should be willing to do business with CASA members. The turn-over should be from R 100m and above. . **The fee is R100, 000.00 per year**
- o Gold Corporate Membership:
This category has got Publicity can also partake in the CASA Policy –making; can also be part of CASA Delegations / Representations (both Local & Abroad). The turn-over should be between R50 million to 100 million. **The fee is R50, 000.00 per year.**
- o Silver Corporate Members:
This category does not have much publicity but can also partake in CASA Activities i.e. Summits / Conferences etc. can also interact with CASA various structures. Their turn-over is between R10 million to 50 million .**The fee is R15, 000.00 per year.**
- o Small Enterprises:
This category comprise of small business that want to make special contribution to CASA. Or with turn-over bellow 10 million. **The fee is R3, 000.00 per year.**

c. Honorary members

They still fill in the membership forms, but the Executive Committee has to confer their honorary membership, after which Membership Department shall advise them accordingly. This category is free. The membership department shall submit the list of honorary membership applications through to the National Executive Committee.
